GETTING STARTED - FIRST STEPS

As your students settle into school, it is time to get your STRIDE program up and running.

- 1. Submit your full school roster 1st through 6th grade
 - This list (MS Excel) should include each student's first name, last name, teacher and grade. Please submit to Ellen Moore at ellen@runsra.org.
- 2. Get your gear up and running Build your student badge rack, find the right place to store it, determine how you will distribute the scanners, etc.
- 3. Create your student badge cards Organize, print, sticker and laminate your student badge cards.
