



SRA HALL OF FAME AND ANNUAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Eligibility and Induction Criteria/Guidelines

OVERVIEW

The Greater Sacramento area boasts some tremendous running talent from Olympic gold medalists to collegiate heroes and high school legends. To honor these individuals from the past and to recognize those who are making history today, the Sacramento Running Association (SRA) is proud to manage the Hall of Fame and Annual Achievement Awards.

Developed in 2013, the SRA inducts individuals and groups into the Hall of Fame who have made significant contributions to the sport of long distance running either through excellence in the sport or significant contributions to the sport. The SRA also recognizes and honors the best performances and achievements from the proceeding year with the Annual Achievement Awards. The Annual Achievement Awards recognize excellence in a variety of divisions ranging from youth runners to 80+ veterans in events ranging from the 800 meters to 100+ milers. The SRA also names one individual that has brought above average recognition to himself/herself and the Sacramento area as the Athlete of the Year.

HALL OF FAME

Selection Criteria:

- Must have brought above average recognition to himself/herself and the Sacramento areas because of successful running endeavors.
- Must have made significant contributions to the sport of long distance running either through excellence in the sport or significant contributions to the sport.
- Must live in, have lived in or be connected to the Greater Sacramento area (4 county region: Sacramento, Yolo, Placer and El Dorado).
- Must be several years removed from most significant achievement related to the sport.

Selection Process:

- Hall of Fame committee review initial list in the spring.
- Open public nomination process on April 1. Close on April 15.
- Committee select inductees. Finalize inductee list during May meeting.
- Inductees need to fit within categories or divisions relative to the other inductees in their class.

ANNUAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS**Selection Criteria:**

- Balance best single performance and best cumulative performances in division during proceeding year.
- Must live in or be connected to the Greater Sacramento area (4 county region: Sacramento, Yolo, Placer and El Dorado).

Selection Process:

- Open public nomination process on July 1. Close nominations on July 15.
- AAA selection committee reviews stats and selects winners by July 20.
- The awards cycle runs August 1 to July 30
- Selection committee consists of SRA staff, SRA Board and representatives from the Sacramento running committee.

Awards:

- Do not need to have an honoree in every division.
- Individuals are eligible to be honored in multiple divisions.
